**Minutes of Regular Meeting of The Rockton Fire
and Police Commission on February 12, 2019**

Placing the advertisement on social media and the Blueline was discussed, as well as the legal requirement of placing the advertisement in the local newspaper. A brief discussion of payment for the advertising took place. The consensus was that the Police Department would bring the bill for the advertising to the Commission and the Commission will be responsible for paying it.

Other Commission Business


Chairman Stewart signed the Resolution scheduling regular monthly 2019 Commission meetings on the second Tuesday of each month beginning in February.
