

**BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE MINUTES**  
**JULY 6, 2010**

Mr. Winters called the regular meeting of the Budget and Finance Committee to order at 6:30p.m. Present were: Dave Winters, Joshua Brown, Scott Fridly, Judy Rossi, Attorney Galluzzo, and Mayor Adams.

Motion by Mr. Fridly, second by Mr. Brown to waive the reading of and approve the minutes of June 22, 2010. All ayes. Motion carried 3-0.

Bills were reviewed and approved in the amount of \$151,785.48 .

Committee member asked questions regarding the use of a village vehicle by the Code Enforcement Officer. They asked the mayor to look into the cost to put signage on the side of the vehicle, and also stated that the code enforcement vehicle is not to leave the village.

Mr. Winters asked Attorney Galluzzo to explain his billing regarding the attempt to enforce the clean-up of the property located at 2169 Broadmoor. Attorney Galluzzo explained examined the bill and gave an explanation of the billing and stated that the complaint against the owner was ready to be served. Mr. Winters asked whether or not the village would be able to recover the legal expenses involved in enforcing this code violation. Attorney Galluzzo stated that they would try to ask the judge for reimbursement for the legal expenses involved.
