Minutes

Vice Chair Leanne Wright called the meeting to order at 6:07 pm.

I. Roll Call

II. Approval of November 15, 2017 Meeting Minutes

III. General Discussion

Ms. Diduch gave a brief update on a few of the items discussed at the November meeting, primarily the CLG application and the website. Ms. Diduch stated the complete CLG application is to be mailed the following day. She also stated that a landing page for the HPC would be created on the Village's website.

Ms. Mathwich then began discussing the walking tour. Ms. Wright updated Mr. Anderson on the Clio smart phone app the Commission is going to use. Ms. Mathwich asked the Commission for direction regarding the brochure creation. She then passed out an overview of different concepts. Discussion ensued regarding the difference between the Rockton Township Historical Society and Commission's programming and figuring out how to maximize efforts. The Commission discussed trying to coordinate the walking tours with the Rockton River Market. Mr. Anderson suggested committing to doing walking tours on June 20, July 18 and August 15. Ms. Wright suggested doing different times to see which time will work best for participants. A time was settled upon of 4:30 pm, and the tour would last one hour.

Ms. Sherwood suggested focusing on Chapel St. for the first walking tour. A lengthy discussion regarding the tour length and subject material ensued.
